Dear Shoreline Resident:

I'm excited to share that the City of Shoreline has begun planning for pedestrian improvements in your neighborhood. This spring, our consultant team, KPFF, will begin designing a new sidewalk for 5th Avenue NE between NE 175th Street and NE 182nd Court.

These improvements are part of a voter-approved effort to build and repair sidewalks throughout the City. In the coming months, KPFF will develop a design for pedestrian facilities to serve 5th Avenue NE in the North City neighborhood and connect with existing pedestrian facilities in the area.

Design of this project will involve land surveying or other field investigations that require our consultants to enter your property. Consequently, a Property Access Permission form and postage-paid return envelope are enclosed; please complete and sign the form and return it at your earliest convenience. I also wanted to take the opportunity to introduce the City's real estate consultant for the project, RES Group NW. There may be a time in the future that this consultant will reach out to you to discuss potential temporary easements.
