Subject: Limited Right of Entry to Conduct Topographic Survey for the 175th Street Corridor Improvements Project

Dear [Taxpayer of Record] or [Occupant]

I am writing to request your permission to access your property located at [Property Address], in the City of Shoreline, to conduct a topographic survey for the City's 175th Street Corridor Improvements Project. A more detailed description of this project can be found on the City's website at <a href="https://www.shorelinewa.gov/175corridor">www.shorelinewa.gov/175corridor</a>. The City's records indicate that your property may be impacted by the City's proposed improvements. Therefore, the City needs to access your property to determine impacts, if any, and to assist with design of the project. If your property is leased, the tenant must sign the enclosed Limited Right of Entry Agreement or, you must provide your tenant's written consent authorizing you to grant access to the City and the tenant's contact information. If the Taxpayer of Record's mailing address is different than the property's address, a Limited Right of Entry Agreement has also been sent to the property address.

Although most topographic survey activities will be limited to the street right-of-way, there are a few select locations where on-property detail is needed. This work would not involve cutting vegetation and would not involve excavation. Efforts will be made to minimize disruption of landscaping and other existing features.

Information obtained will be used in the preparation of the City's roadway design documents. Upon completion of this design phase, if it is determined the project will impact your property, the City will coordinate with you for property restoration or adjustments.

Please sign the enclosed Limited Right of Entry Agreement by Monday, February 28, 2022. An addressed, pre-paid postage enveloped is enclosed for your convenience.
