Highlights: During the month of April, Shoreline CIU served 2 emergency field search warrants. 1 involved the Days Inn and the other an assist to Bothell PD, in both instances the Detectives assigned had the warrants written and signed in expedited fashion. This allowed support units to complete their tasks without wasted effort or time. The warrants netted 4 firearms used in the commission of crimes to include Felonious Assault and Robbery. CIU also assisted the Pct 5 SET team on a warrant that netted a vast quantity of narcotics mostly Fentanyl pills and powder, and the seizure of over \$200000 in cash, and several firearms.

There was an uptick in commercial burglaries for the month, which was mostly related to public storage units being broken into, and Detectives are actively looking into those.
