Highlights: Shoreline CIU is seeing an increase in case load as we take on new classification of crimes that we had previously only worked on occasion. Commercial burglaries decreased slightly from Nov, but we are still experiencing burglaries involving vehicles being used to smash storefronts. Auto thefts increased slightly, while vehicle prowls were down slightly. We served 1 search warrants on vehicles at the Pct. We were able to clear up some of the storage unit burglaries, recommending charges on 2 brothers who are responsible for multiple burglaries.
