Mayor and Honorable Councilmembers,

KCRHA is pleased to release our 2024 Point-In-Time (PIT) count. The PIT is a biennial HUD-mandated report, which is made up of two segments — a sheltered count, and an unsheltered count. As you will see in the one-pager our sheltered count stayed relatively stable, which makes sense given that our shelter bed inventory remained relatively stable. However, the number of people experiencing unsheltered homelessness is higher compared to our 2022 report. Attached, please find a one-pager and an FAQ.

We're sharing this information to give you time to review it before we release it to reporters at Noon today. Please refrain from sharing it with them before we release it.
