Highlights:

Shoreline CIU Detectives assisted the KCSO SAU team with removing an abused child from a Shoreline home during a child torture investigation.

Shoreline CIU Detectives followed up on a crime tip alleging criminal activity at a Shoreline residence. The investigation led to a stolen motorcycle that was taken from the city of Seattle and a stolen trailer taken from a residence in Shoreline. Both were returned to their owners and the location was referred to the Shoreline SET Team.
