Construction updates for March 7, 2025

Construction is ongoing along N 145th Street between 1st Avenue NE and I-5. Please reduce your speed while driving through the construction zone. Please help us keep our crews and those traveling through the area safe!

1st Avenue NE closed south of N 145th through April

1st Avenue NE is now closed at the south end of the N 145th Street intersection. The closure is expected to continue through April. During this time, through traffic is not be permitted; only local access will be allowed. A signed detour will be in place and traffic is able to detour to Meridian Avenue N. Construction activities include wall construction, intersection and signal improvements, and installation of sewer and storm systems.



1st Avenue NE is closed to through traffic at the south end of the N 145th Street intersection.

Lane reduction on N 145th Street and potential backups

One lane in each direction of N 145th Street will remain closed until the construction of roundabouts at I-5 later this year. Expect backups during peak travel times in the morning and afternoon; consider alternate routes and plan ahead.

Work schedule

- SPU crews are working on sewer connections at 4th Avenue and N 145th Street.
- Work continues on 5th Avenue at NE 145th Street.
- Crews continue to work within the closure limits and between 1st and Meridian Avenues.
- Seattle City Light crews continue working in the construction area installing poles and disconnecting old service lines.
- Lumen and Comcast crews continue working in the area connecting underground systems to new infrastructure.
- Construction crews working for the City of Shoreline are working in the area Monday Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Closure and detour updates

- The northbound I-5 off-ramp to N 145th Street will close from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. for a single night between March 17 and 24. An updated schedule will be provided when available.
- 1st Avenue NE is now closed at the south end of the N 145th Street intersection. The closure is expected to continue through the end of April. During this time, through traffic is not permitted; only local access is allowed. A signed detour is in place and traffic is able to detour to Meridian Avenue North.
- Flaggers may alternate traffic on weekdays at the intersection of N 145th Street and Corliss Avenue. Expect delays.
- Flaggers will alternate traffic on 1st Avenue at N 145th and 147th Streets during the construction of a private development.
- A pedestrian and bicycle detour along N 145th Street is in place. The detour reconnects 5th and 1st Avenues NE via NE 145th Street.

- To avoid traffic delays on 145th Street during peak travel times, the primary detour routes when heading east and west are N 155th and N 130th Streets.
- Coordination with partner transportation agencies like Sound Transit, WSDOT, Seattle DOT and King County Metro is ongoing.
