Violent Crimes and Trafficking Detective - Finan

Note: I was on vacation for 1 week in April.

- I completed 20 outside agency assists relating to social media, gang, and human trafficking intelligence.
- Attended the King County Regional Violent Crime Intelligence Meeting and presented on the new Black Disciples gang set operating in the region.
- Gave presentation at the Snohomish County Regional Gang Meeting. Made contacts with gang officers in Mountlake Terrace, Lynnwood, Everett, and Sno County SO.
- Along with Det. Veile, gave a presentation on the local gangs to the Shoreline School District admin, principals, and asst. principals. Used the opportunity to build relationships with the district reps and opened lines of communication.
- Developed a "Investigative Resources" patrol training to educate patrol officers on the resources available to enhance street level investigations. Will plan to present to PCT-5 patrol in the near future.
- Assisted SPD with social media intelligence related to a homicide in South Seattle
- Identified two primary suspects in a large HSI drug case and provided HSI with their social media accounts
- KCSO Assists:
 - Provided social media and gang intel to Seatac SET Dets for their primary target in a gun and trafficking INV. Also identified one of their target's criminal associates.
 - Assisted Shoreline SET with rolling surveillance on Aurora to try and recover multiple juvenile trafficking victims.
 - Provided ZZ-Group with intel on a street racing group planning to pass through Shoreline

• Notable cases as Primary:

<u>C25006159</u>: After the suspect in my case, Jamonney C. Green (07/02/03), was arrested by Kent PD patrol, I served a search warrant on the vehicle he was in. I recovered a Glock-20 with a switch, a drum magazine, and extended mag, and 81 rounds of 10mm. I filed my case with the King County prosecutor's office and they charged Green with Assault-1 (Drive-By Shooting) and UPFA-1 (x3). His arrest warrant on my case is for \$750K. The case is being presented to the AUSA for federal adoption.

<u>C25011871</u>: Identified a 15-year-old juvenile female being trafficked on Aurora after her sister made a post on a popular Instagram account related to prostitution. Initiated a case in order to try and recover the juvenile victim and identify her trafficker(s).

<u>C25003891</u>: Wrote Google warrant to try and confirm the identity of the suspect in an MV Theft case.
