Dear Mayor Roberts,


I would like to congratulate Shoreline on completing the comprehensive plan update and thank you and your staff for working with the Puget Sound Regional Council through the certification process. On June 26, 2025, PSRC's Executive Board acted to certify the Shoreline 2024 Comprehensive Plan. This recognizes that the transportation-related provisions in the comprehensive plan conform to the Growth Management Act and are substantially consistent with multicounty planning policies and the Regional Transportation Plan. Certification makes your jurisdiction eligible to apply for PSRC's federal transportation funding and program funds in the Regional Transportation Improvement Program.

Coordinated planning is a hallmark of the Growth Management Act and [VISION 2050](#), the region's long-range plan. In a growing region, it is essential that jurisdictions work together on shared goals such as mobility, housing affordability, and protecting our environment. The city's plan helps move the region forward in advancing those goals.

PSRC has prepared a [certification report](#) that contains a summary of PSRC's review of the Shoreline 2024 Comprehensive Plan. PSRC staff coordinated with city staff in the development of the report. The report describes the scope of the certification review as guided by the [Plan Review Manual](#), summarizes findings from the plan, and identifies areas where future work is needed to further VISION 2050, the Regional Transportation Plan, and the Growth Management Act.
