Violent Crimes and Trafficking Detective (VCAT):

- Detective Dan Finan completed 12 outside agency assists relating to social media, gang, and human trafficking intelligence.

- Provided Aberdeen PD with intel stemming from Det. Finan's trafficking investigation to assist in their attempt to disrupt a group of Norteño gang members running drugs, guns, and females in their town
- Identified a felony theft suspect for Bellevue PD
- Provided the FBI with a social media account for a missing/endangered juvenile sex trafficking victim
- Notable cases:
 - C25013990: Filed Human Trafficking-2 (HT-2) and Promoting-1 (CSAM) charges on Kamario Washington relating to his trafficking of a 17-year-old runaway.
 - C25016734: Shoreline Homicide Investigation

The bulk of Det. Finan's work in June was spent as a co-lead investigator on the homicide of a 15-year-old at the Polaris Apartments on 06/02. The day the victim's body was discovered, Det. Finan located social media evidence which established a prior relationship between the victim and his HT-2 suspect (Kamario Washington). This evidence also helped to quickly identify the female victim. He immediately wrote multiple social media and electronic surveillance warrants, which were submitted on 06/03. Evidence obtained from the warrants confirmed the connection between the victim and Kamario, and helped investigators establish a timeline for the victim's movements leading up to her arrival in Shoreline. He was also able to confirm Kamario's ID after there was confusion relating to his use of his older brother's ID.

In mid-June, Det. Finan obtained Kamario's new phone number and established that the phone was purchased by his sister. He wrote additional warrants, including a PRTT on the phone to locate him. When his location pinged in Los Angeles, he coordinated with LAPD and the ATF task force to go up on surveillance. Kamario was arrested by LAPD gang officers on 07/03 on Det. Finan's 50-state Human Trafficking warrant. He wrote 6 different warrants for the case, including the social media warrants that gave Shoreline PD/KCSO communications between the suspect and victim, and the ping/CDR warrant that allowed us to map the suspect's movements post-murder and locate him in California.
