Violent Crimes and Trafficking Detective

- Det. Finan completed 12 outside agency assists relating to social media, gang, and human trafficking intelligence
- Human Trafficking OP: He participated in a HT hotel OP hosted by Lakewood PD. He assisted with intel gathering and interviews. During the OP, Det. Finan identified a detained female as a subject with an Attempted Murder warrant out of Portland, OR. He also obtained valuable intel about a pimp he'd previously identified as operating out of the Shoreline Days Inn and on Aurora Ave N.
- KCSO Assists:
 - He participated in a Sound Transit gang meeting and later met with two ST deputies to share intel and educate them on King County gang activity
 - He conducted Intel sharing with Det. Short RE active pimps and trafficking victims in King County
 - He identified the group of juveniles hanging out at The Quinn Apartments in Shoreline as a new Gangster Disciple clique called "Shark Gang." Shared the intel with KCSO crime analysts and investigators in south King County where some of the kids live.
 - **C25036426:** Detectives Monserud and Finan responded to a structure fire in Shoreline in which an elderly resident was found deceased. They assisted MCU Dets by gathering as much intel/evidence as possible and getting recorded interviews from the SFD witnesses prior to MCU's arrival. **The MCU Dets were grateful for their help and said the assist saved them a lot of time. They remarked that their response was one they typically don't get from precinct detectives.**
- Cases:
 - **C25037874 – VICE/Agency Assist:** Det. Finan was contacted by Bend PD regarding a female he'd previously identified when she was working out of the Shoreline Days Inn. The female was the victim of a felony DV assault and kidnapping. Dets from Bend were attempting to locate the female's former trafficker and father of her child. Finan provided Bend with intel about the female victim and male suspect, including social media accounts. He also captured a social media post of the male suspect with the female's young daughter, who he was not supposed to have contact with. Bend Dets were going to use the info in his agency assist report to apply for multiple search warrants.
 - **C25037994 – DV Strangulation:** This case was taken by patrol. Det. Finan referred felony assault and MV Theft charges to the prosecutor's office.
