C26004487: Bomb Threat

- Bomb threat called into Shoreline utilities. Det. Finan was able to determine if the phone number was spoofed and the same subject had made swatting calls all over the country

C26004082: Threats Call

- Threats made on social media towards ICE agents by a Shoreline resident. Reviewed/documentated his online activity and determined the threats weren't specific enough to constitute a crime. Report taken for info.

C26005024: UPFA

- Juvenile UPFA. Shoreline 8th grader was in possession of a firearm at his adult brother's apartment.
- Referred UPFA charges to Juvi.

C26004511: Burg-1

- Group of juvenile gang members at the Quinn apartments broke down the victim's door and pistol whipped him. There were 10 subjects in total who were either participants or witnesses to the assault. Det. Finan identified half the subjects involved and is working to develop PC.

C26003299: Weapons Surrender

- Handled a weapons surrender for patrol relating to a court order.

C25034081: Attempted Robbery

- Referred Felony charges to prosecutor's office

C26003964: UPFA

- Observed a stolen firearm out of Federal Way on an IG account of a known gang member. Initiated an UPFA investigation.
